The authors regret a mistake in reporting the testing conditions of the two-electrode system of supercapacitors.

On page 13011, left column, line 2, the sentence "Specifically, it was composed of a glassy fibrous separator and our samples in 6 M KOH solution." should read "Specifically, it was composed of a glassy fibrous separator and our samples in 6 M KOH solution or 1 M  $Et_4NBF_4/PC$  electrolyte ( $Et_4NBF_4$  = tetraethylammonium tetrafluoroborate; PC = propylene carbonate)."

On page 13016, right column, line 9, the sentence "To evaluate its application as electrodes, a supercapacitor based on the asprepared ITC-JG-900 was assembled" should read "To evaluate its application as electrodes, a supercapacitor based on the asprepared ITC-JG-900 was assembled in 1 M  $\rm Et_4NBF_4/PC$  electrolyte".

On page 13017, left column, line 8, the sentence "this value still remains at 38.8 W h kg<sup>-1</sup> at a high power density of 12 500 W h kg<sup>-1</sup> in 6 M KOH" should read "this value still remains at 38.8 W h kg<sup>-1</sup> at a high power density of 12 500 W h kg<sup>-1</sup> in 1 M  $\rm Et_4NBF_4/PC$  electrolyte".
