Additionally, in the original submission the affiliation of Lijun Xie was listed incorrectly. The correct affiliation is shown below.

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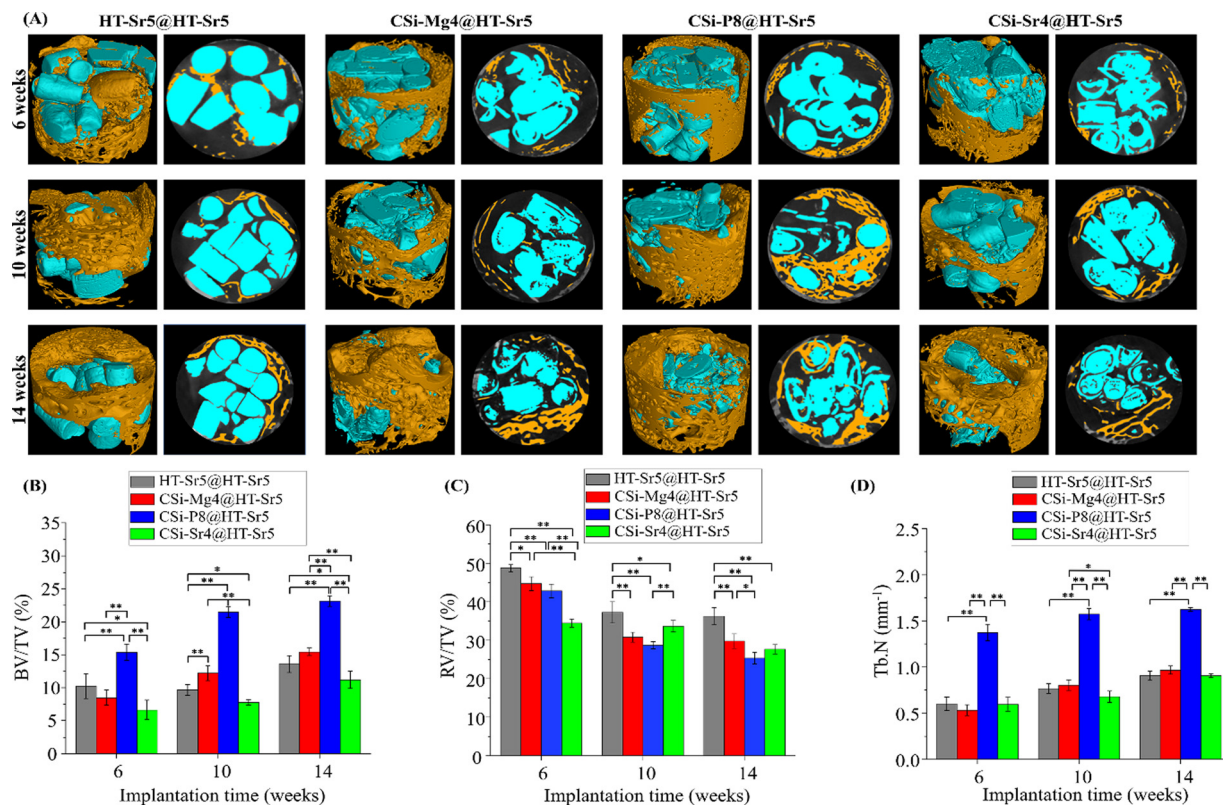


Fig. 7 2D and 3D  $\mu$ CT reconstructed images of femoral bone defects filled with bioceramic granules (A) and the quantitative analyses of the BV/TV (B; bone volume/total volume), RV/TV (C; residual volume/total volume), and Tb.N (D; trabecular number) in the bone defect areas after implantation for 6, 10, and 14 weeks, respectively. \* $p < 0.05$ ; \*\* $p < 0.01$ .
