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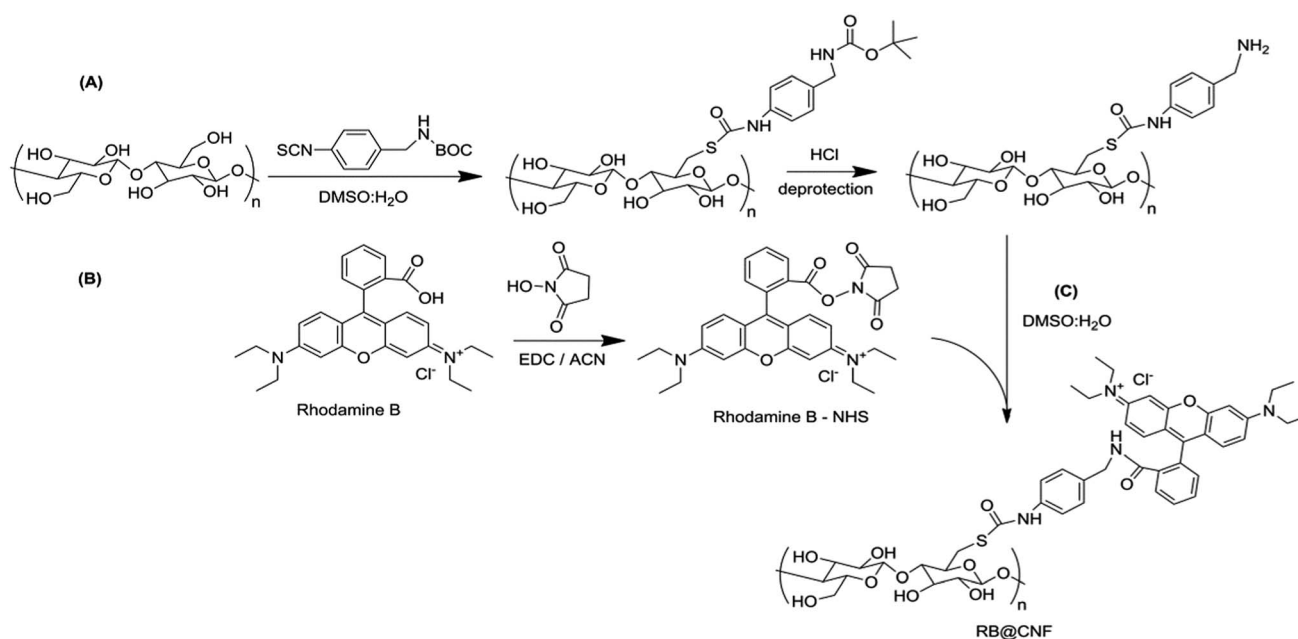
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Correction: Labelling of *N*-hydroxysuccinimide-modified rhodamine B on cellulose nanofibrils by the amidation reaction

(A) Surface modification of the CNF with a terminal amine function; (B) activation of rhodamine B through the *N*-hydroxysuccinimide ester; and (C) fluorescent labeling of the amine-modified CNF by the activated rhodamine B via the production of an amide bond.
