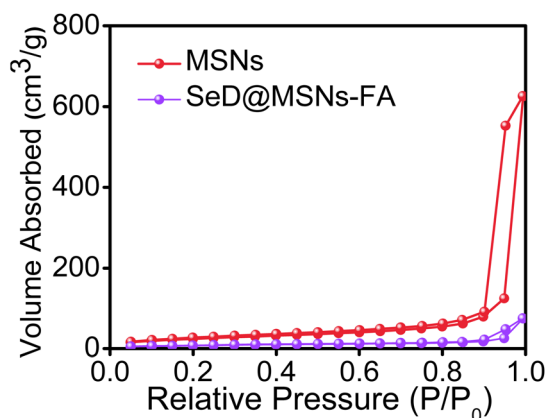


Fig. 1 (G) N₂ adsorption–desorption isotherm.

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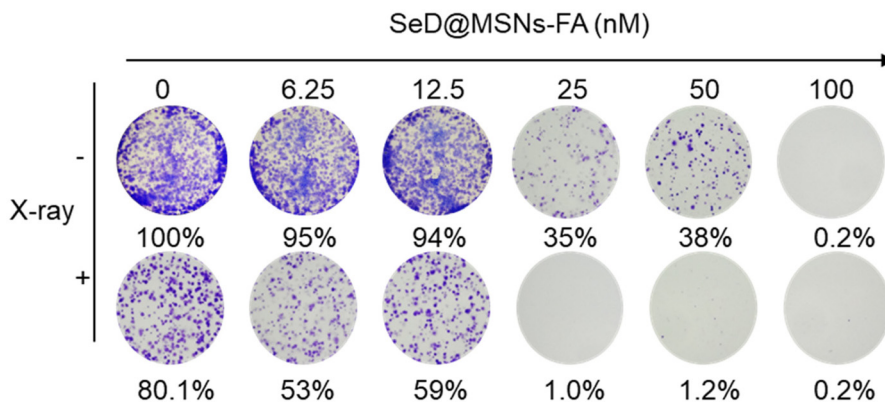


Fig. 2 (D) HeLa cells were cultured in 6-well plates with specific concentrations of SeD@MSNs-FA and radiation (2 Gy), and a clonogenic assay was performed over 8 days.
