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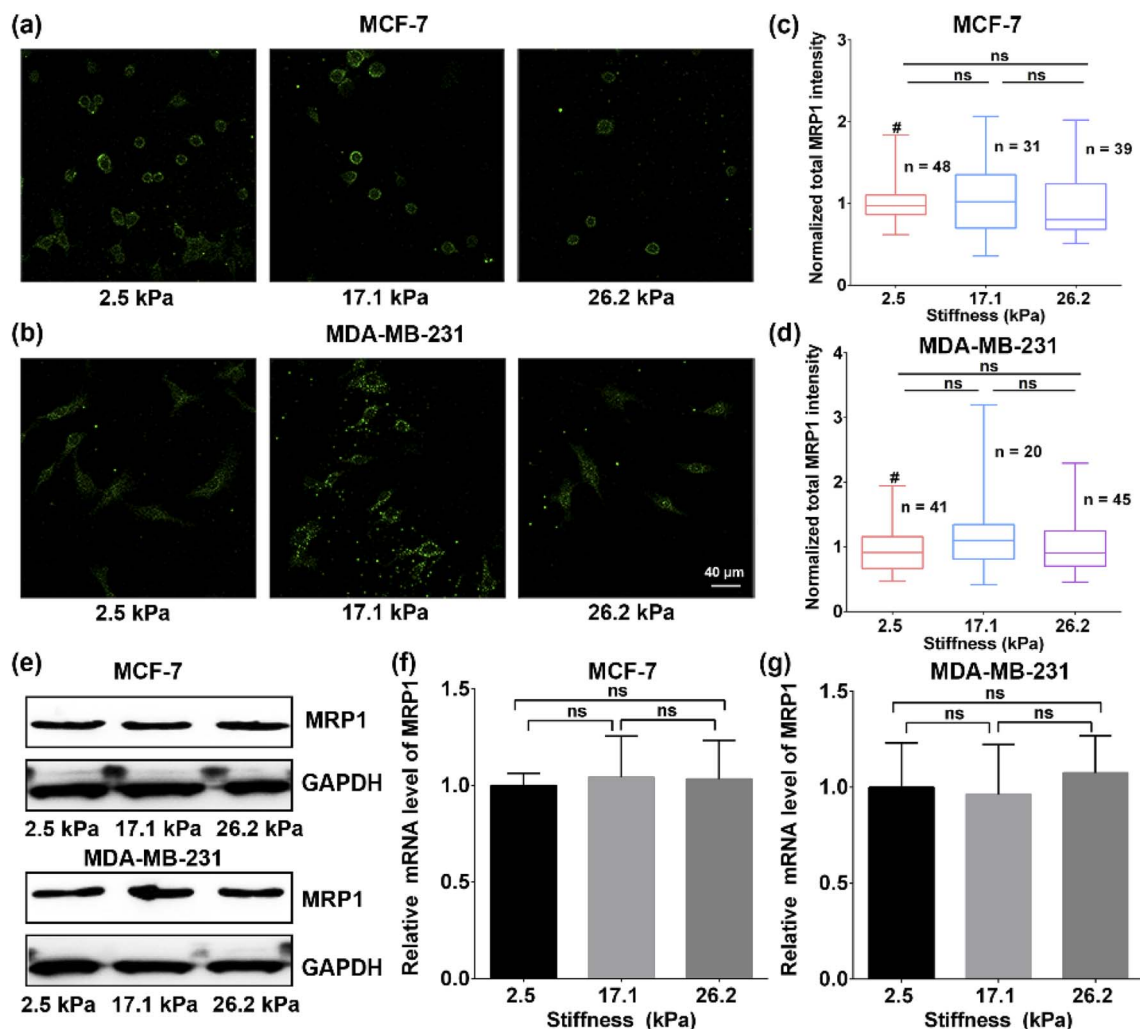


Fig. 5 (a and b) Immunofluorescence images and (c and d) the normalized total MRP1 intensities of (a and c) MCF cells and (b and d) MDA-MB-231 cells on the PA gels with stiffness of 2.5, 17.1 and 26.2 kPa, respectively (scale bar: 40  $\mu\text{m}$ ). (e) Western blot analysis of the MRP1 expressions of the MCF-7 and MDA-MB-231 cells on the PA gels with stiffness of 2.5, 17.1 and 26.2 kPa, respectively. (f and g) The relative MRP1 mRNA expressions in (f) the MCF-7 cells and (g) the MDA-MB-231 cells on the PA gels with stiffness of 2.5, 17.1 and 26.2 kPa, respectively.

This error does not affect the conclusions of the original article as the correct Fig. 5f also proves that there is no significant difference in the mRNA levels of MRP1 in the MCF-7 cells on the PA gels with three stiffness.
