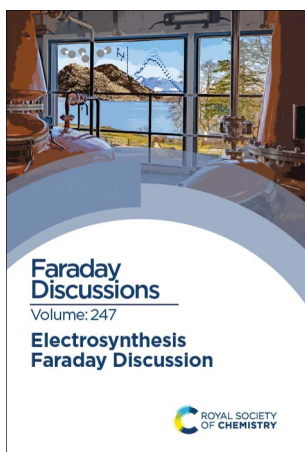
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A General Discussion on Electrosynthesis was held in Edinburgh, UK and online on the 12th, 13th and 14th of July 2023.
