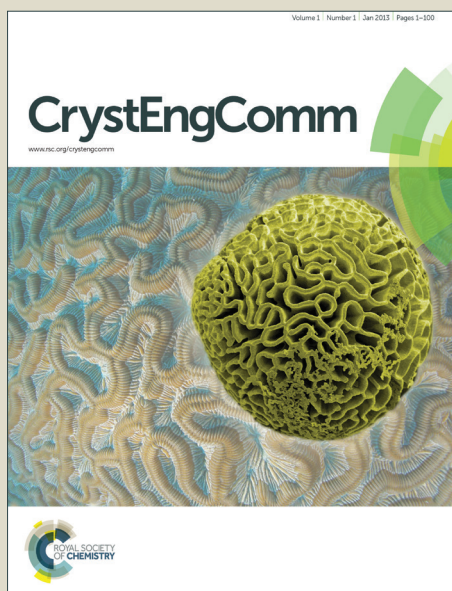


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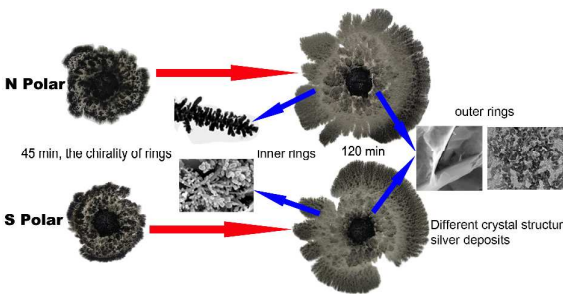


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The external magnetic field can control the chirality of Liesegang rings and induce the change of silver crystal structure.
