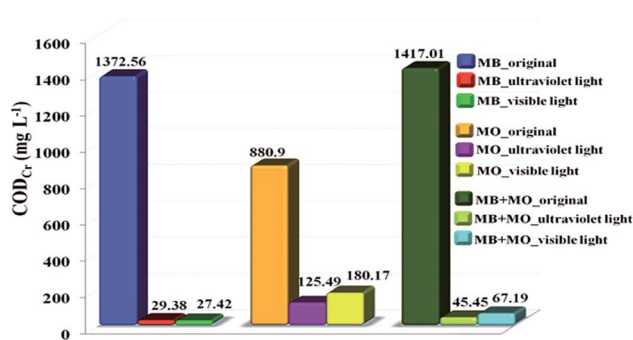


Fig. 11 The COD_{Cr} changes of MB, MO and MB + MO mixture before and after UV or visible light irradiation in the presence of 1.

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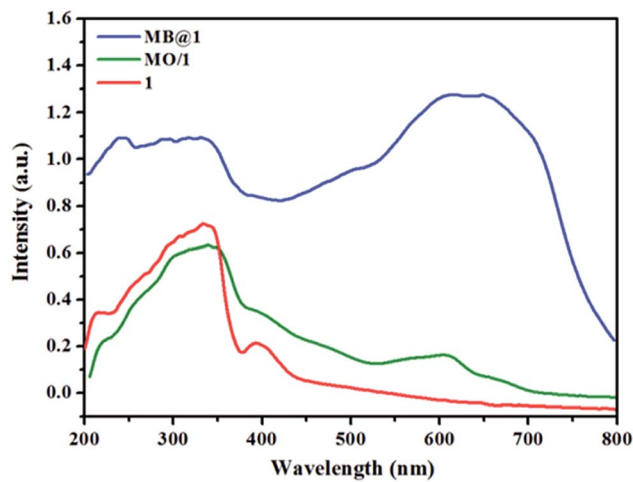


Fig. 12 The UV-Vis diffuse reflectance spectra of 1, MB@1 and MO/1.
