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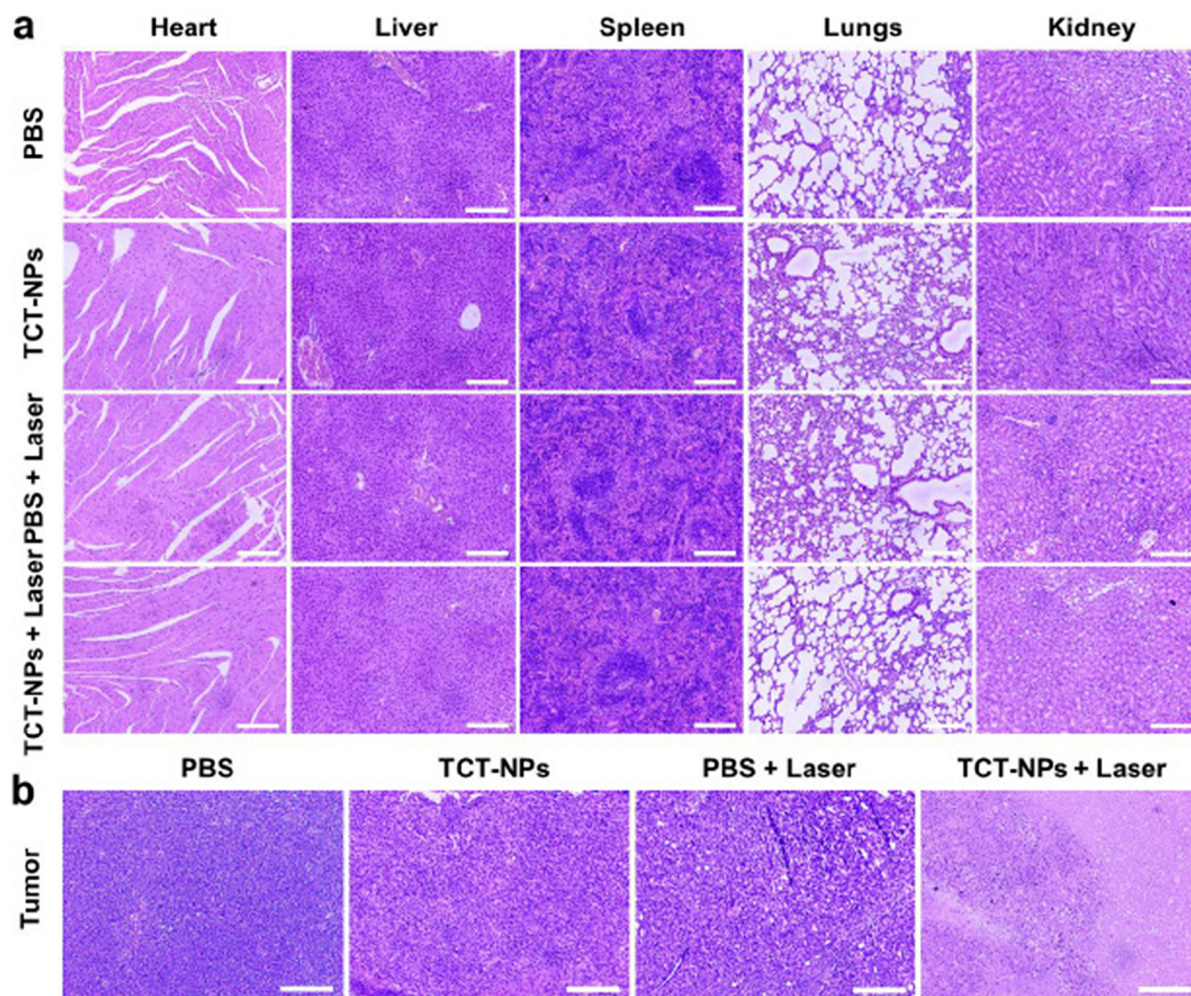


Fig. 6 Histological examination of the main organs and tumors of mice in four groups. (a) H&E staining of the major organs; (b) H&E staining of tumor sections (scale = 200 μm).

The authors regret an error in Fig. 6 in the original manuscript. The correct version of Fig. 6 is as shown below.
